ULI Student Membership Scholarship Objectives:

ULI Student Membership Requirements:

- Attend a minimum of one ULI event per semester (Spring '13 and Fall '13). Award recipients are required to inform the ULI Liaison of which events they attend. Event registration lists are published, and attendance is recorded, by ULI.
- Write one article for the ULI page of the UPC newsletter per semester. Coordination with the ULI Liaison and Newsletter Editor is required. If necessary, your submission will be edited, with your consent, by the ULI Liaison and/or Newsletter Editor prior to submission. The intent of the review is to check for grammatical errors and to ensure clear communication; it is not meant to alter the message of the article.
- You may be asked by the ULI Liaison to write about an event for the ULI blog. Your article must be reviewed by the ULI Liaison prior to submission to ULI. If necessary, your submission will be edited, with your consent, by the ULI Liaison prior to submission. The intent of the review is to check for grammatical errors and to ensure clear communication; it is not meant to alter the message of the article.
- You are encouraged (not required) to volunteer to work registration for one ULI event per semester. With reasonable notice, the ULI Liaison can arrange free registration to an event in exchange for volunteering at the registration table.
